Definition

The National Society of the Sons of the American Revolution is a historical, educational, and patriotic "lineage" society comprised of male descendants of patriots who supported the cause of American Independence during the years 1774-1783.

Membership is open to any man who can document his ancestry to an American Patriot of the Revolutionary era. The Patriot need not have been a soldier; Patriots were people (men and women) who gave tangible assistance to the cause of independence.
